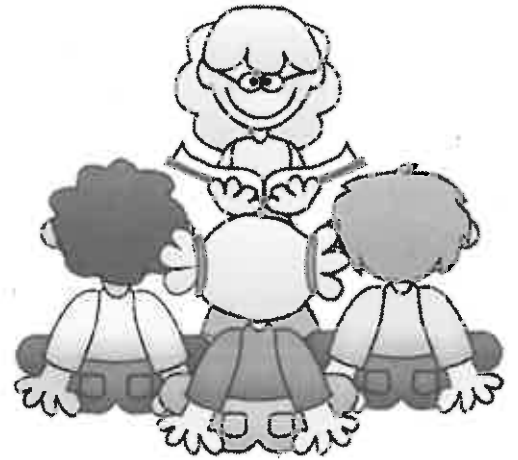


# Mrs. Klerna's

Kindergarten Supply List

- ❖ **Regular Sized Book Bag** - Please label with your child's name.
- ❖ **2 Folders** - Your child will need a two pocket folder to travel back and forth to school every day with important papers...the extra folder is in case the original folder is lost. Please get folders with pockets on the bottom not on the sides. Please label both folders with your child's name.
- ❖ **Small blanket/pillow** - to rest on during a short quiet time each day. Please label these with your child's name
- ❖ **Extra clothes to keep at school** - please put these clothes, including underwear, in a large labeled zip lock bag so that we can store them in your child's cubby in case of an accident or spill. Accidents happen when you least expect them (even if they haven't happened in years). It makes for less embarrassment and wasted time if your child can use their own clean clothes instead of waiting for you to bring a fresh set from home.
- ❖ **Paint smock** - Please label with your child's name. You do not need to buy a fancy smock. A paint smock can be an old t-shirt from home.
- ❖ **1 Plastic Supply Box** - approx. 5"x8"
- ❖ **1 package of Crayola Markers (8 count)**
- ❖ **3 boxes of 16 count Crayola crayons**
- ❖ **1 package of 250 napkins**
- ❖ **6 packages of glue sticks**
- ❖ **1 pair of Fiskars child size scissors (pointed tip)**

**School Supplies Your Child Will Need For Kindergarten:** (Students should be prepared with these things on the first day of school)

- **Extra clothes to keep at school-** please put these clothes, including underwear, in a large labeled zip lock bag so that we can store them in your child's cubby in case of an accident or spill. Accidents happen when you least expect them (even if they haven't happened in years). It makes for less embarrassment and wasted time if your child can use their own clean clothes instead of waiting for you to bring a fresh set from home. Please label each piece of clothing with your child's name.
- **Small blanket or beach towel** to rest on during a short quiet time each day. Please label this with your child's name.
- **Book bag-** please make sure that your child's book bag is large enough to hold a folder, winter clothes, lunch box, sneakers, ect. Please label your child's book bag with his or her name.
- **1 package of 250 napkins**
- **One standard size pencil box**
- **3 boxes of 16 Crayola Crayons-** Please make sure they are Crayola brand only 16 count so that your child has the same colors as everyone else
- **Small paper plates or plastic cups or sandwich size ziplock bags** (if your last name starts with A-I send a package of **small paper plates**, if your last name starts with J-P send a package of plastic cups, if your last name starts with Q-Z send a box of sandwich size ziplock bags)
- **Paint smock-** please label this with your child's name. You do not need to buy a fancy smock. A paint smock can be a large old shirt from home.
- **4 packages of glue sticks**
- **Package of standard yellow #2 pencils**
- **Folder-** Your child will need a two pocket folder to travel back and forth to school everyday with important papers. Please get a folder with the pockets on the bottom and not on the sides. Please label the folder with your child's name. **It is imperative that your child return this folder every day.** At this age, kids sometimes don't understand how important it is to give you a note that I sent home with them, and the same is true with a note that you may send to school for me. Therefore, please make every effort each night to go through their book bags and folders with them. Please put any papers or notes you have for me or the school in their folder. Each morning I check every child's folder. I will not check all of the little zipper pockets in the book bag and I do not want important papers (like dismissal notes) to get misplaced.. Please place any money for lunch, book orders, field trips, ect. In a clearly labeled envelope.
- **Extra plastic folder to keep at school in case their original folder is lost.** Please label this "Extra Folder" and also write your child's name on it.

One of the most important things to remember is that you need to label **EVERYTHING** you send into school with your child. With 20 similar items coming into school each day it is very easy for things to get lost or misplaced.
