Kindergarten Supply List

- ❖ **Regular Sized Book Bag** - Please label with your child's name.
- ❖ **2 Folders** - Your child will need a two pocket folder to travel back and forth to school every day with important papers...the extra folder is in case the original folder is lost. Please get folders with pockets on the bottom not on the sides. Please label both folders with your child's name.
- ❖ **1 Container of Clorox Wipes**
- ❖ **Small blanket/pillow** - to rest on during a short quiet time each day. Please label these with your child's name
- ❖ **Extra clothes to keep at school** - please put these clothes, including underwear, in a large labeled zip lock bag so that we can store them in your child's cubby in case of an accident or spill. Accidents happen when you least expect them (even if they haven't happened in years). It makes for less embarrassment and wasted time if your child can use their own clean clothes instead of waiting for you to bring a fresh set from home.
